The cemetery is known as a lawn cemetery, with the intention of no planting or cultivation; we are concerned that over recent years there has been an increase in several graves that have been cultivated, as well as the addition of glass vases, ornaments, solar lights and other paraphernalia. Whilst these may seem acceptable they make the maintenance of the cemetery difficult for the groundsmen.



In the Autumn, Steve Legg and volunteers from the Huntingdon Rotary Club attended to help tidy up the churchyard & cemetery. Our thanks go to them and they are hoping to return again soon.

The Parish Council are in the process of securing further land, which is needed to extend the existing cemetery and we hope this will be confirmed in the near future.
