

Greens & Footpaths Report

All footpaths within the Parish boundry but not pavements come under the greens and footpath banners, also the large green opposite the school and the smaller green on the high street and the corner of Grove lane. The smaller one has looked wonderful with all the daffodils purchased and planted by the Brampton events group. Well done. The larger green has been home to a summer and winter fete as well as a fair and circus (returns in May) Trees are quite a large expense with professional checks, felling and replacing diseased trees as well as maintenance. I would like to thank the ground staff for keeping the greens looking so delightful and a credit to the village.

The two large maintenance projects in the planning process are the footpath between Huntingdon road and Hinchingbrooke park where we are planning to construct a raised boardwalk over the area that floods and then turns into heavy mud. We are also working with Bellway to improve the path between Hansel way and the new A14/A I. I would just like to add what a pleasure it was to resume the annual village walkabout, where we look at what maintenance is needed around the village, but we are all ways grateful if members of the public can inform the Parish office of anything we have missed.
