

Planning Report April 2022

Over the last two years with the COVID restrictions, planning application decisions have taken more time than pre pandemic. Hopefully, with most of the restrictions now lifted this will in turn accelerate the decision making process made by the District Council.

Between 1st April 2021 and 31st March 2022, the Parish Council received 55 applications and of this the Parish Council recommended approval for 49.

The applications ranged from the usual tree pruning, extensions etc to larger applications including the erection of 16 dwellings east of 66 Thrapston rd which the Parish Council has recommended for approval however the final decision still remains with the District Council.

The Parish Council continues to review all planning applications, taking into account any changes which may affect the village both visually and from traffic, noise, environmental issues etc to allow the most satisfactory decision to be made.
